Keep an eye out for the latest phishing actions aimed at collecting data from the Bank's Customers, through a fraudulent sending of SMS.

If you receive an SMS with the subject "Your device has not been registered", with access to a link, do not click. **ICD Bank does NOT send SMS with links.**

The only codes we ask for when you access ICD Bank are: the **User Code** and **5 random digits of the Access Code**.

We remind you that ICD Bank:

- It does NOT require software installation or update
- DOES NOT send SMS with links
- DOES NOT send Email with links
- DOES NOT request the full Multichannel Code (the 7 digits)
- DOES NOT ask for mobile number
- **DO NOT** request, by phone or other means, the Authorization Code sent by SMS
- **DOES NOT** simulate transactions with Customers
